OFFICE OF INCOME TAX ADMINISTRATION

New Acts Concerning Income Tax

Act 155 – The Arkansas Tax-Deferred Tuition Savings program allows taxpayers who receive interest, dividends, and capital gains from funds invested in this program or a tax-deferred tuition savings program, established by another state under 26 U.S.C. 529, is exempt from Arkansas income taxes. Effective January 1st, 2017.

Act 433 – Due date for Withholding is January 31st following the close of the income year. Effective ninety (90) days after May 1st, 2017.

Act 434 – If a corporation elects to be a Subchapter S corporation for federal income tax purposes, the corporation will be deemed to have the same status for Arkansas income tax purposes. A corporation that elected to be treated as a Subchapter S corporation for federal income tax purposes will not be treated as Subchapter C Corporation for Arkansas income tax purposes. Effective January 1st, 2018.

Act 666 – Teacher's Classroom Investment Deduction. This allows teacher's to deduct "qualified classroom investment expenses" during the tax year for materials used in the classroom such as: books; school supplies; computer equipment and software; athletic equipment; food for the teacher's students; and clothing for the teacher's students. The deduction cannot exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) per taxpayer or five hundred dollars (\$500) for taxpayer who are married filing jointly if each taxpayer is a teacher. A taxpayer claiming this deduction must maintain receipts for his or her qualified classroom investment expenses; and itemize the qualified classroom investment expensed on the form provided by the Department of Finance and Administration. Effective January 1, 2017.

Office of Corporation Income Tax

Act 48 – Arkansas Corporate Income Tax filings are April 15^{th,} beginning in tax year January 1, 2017. This is to align the Arkansas Corporate Income Tax filing date with the Federal government's Corporate Income Tax filing date.

Note: The actual filing date for corporate income tax is on Tuesday, April 18, 2017 because April 15th is on a Saturday.

Enhanced Driver's License and Identification Cards

Effective October 3, 2016, you will have two options when applying for or renewing a driver's license or identification card:

- You may choose the new Arkansas Voluntary Enhanced Security DL or ID. This new card will be compliant with the Federal "REAL ID Act of 2005," and will provide enhanced security from fraud and identity theft. The new card will cost the same as a regular DL or ID card. The new card will also contain a gold star shown on the upper right corner.
- 2. You may choose to renew your regular DL or ID cards, which are not compliant with the Federal "REAL ID Act of 2005." The non-compliant cards will be marked, "Not for Federal Identification," (see photo below).

The new "Enhanced Security Driver's License or Identification Card is 'voluntary' until October 1, 2020. Anyone who boards a domestic flight or enters a federal building will either need an

Arkansas Voluntary Enhanced Security Driver's License (DL) or Identification Card (ID), or will need to provide a regular card and additional accepted forms of identification. This is for the purpose of Arkansas statute being in line with Federal mandate. Please refer images 1 and 2 to see the "Enhanced Driver's License and Identification Card.

The new federally compliant driver's license and identification cards will be marked with a star on the top right corner beside the your 'date of birth' (DOB). See the examples for each DL or ID below:

ATAP is a **FREE** web-based service that gives taxpayers or their designated representative online access to their tax accounts and offers the following services:

- Make a payment.
- Register a business.
- File a return on-line (except individual income tax).
- File a return using XML return upload.
- File an annual reconciliation for withholding tax.
- Change a name on an account.
- Change an address on an account.
- Amend a return.
- Maintain all tax account types via a single login.
- Assign 3rd party logins (CPA, power of attorney, responsible party, & etc.).
- Store banking information for use during payment submission.
- ✤ Upload w-2 information.
- View tax period financial information (tax penalty, interest, credits, balance, & etc.).
- View payments received.
- View recent account activity.
- View correspondence from the department.
